OPEN HOUSE SPINDLETOP EXPANSION PROJECT

Golden Triangle Storage, LLC (GTS), a subsidiary of Caliche Development Partners III, LLC, is seeking authorization from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to construct, own, operate, and maintain the Spindletop Expansion Project in Jefferson County, Texas. The Spindletop Expansion Project will add approximately 30.75 billion cubic feet of new natural gas storage capacity to GTS's existing storage facilities. GTS has filed an application with FERC in Docket No. CP25-167 seeking approval of the Spindletop Expansion Project. Pending approval by FERC, construction is anticipated to begin in the first half of 2026 with an anticipated in-service date for the first of the caverns in the second half of 2028. The Spindletop Expansion Project is needed to satisfy growing demand for natural gas storage in the Gulf Coast region.
